Meeting opened with all Board Members and 9 guests present.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Treasurers Report was read and approved.

Bills were approved as presented.

Paul Olson with Municipal Underwriters of West Michigan discussed Clinton Township's insurance rates and increase in premium for 2025. Also discussed were the valuations of real estate owned by the Township. Paul will re-look at these valuations and get back to us.
